

EDWARD (TED) K. TURNER was born in the Maymont area, and received his elementary and high school education there. He received his diploma in agriculture from the University of Saskatchewan in 1948.

Upon graduation, he operated the family farm, and continued to do so until 1966.

He has served the Saskatchewan Wheat Pool organization for some 36 years, initially as an elected delegate in 1957, becoming a director in 1960, Vice-President in 1966 and finally serving as President from July 1969 to January 1987. Following this long association and career, Mr. Turner was appointed Executive Director of Prairie Pools Inc.

He is Past President of the Boards of Prairie Pools Inc., Canadian Pool Agencies, Pool Insurance Company, Excan Grain Ltd., and Pacific Elevators Ltd., and has served on the Boards of Western Pool Terminals (Vice-President), Prince Rupert Grain Ltd., and Western Cooperative Fertilizers Ltd.

Mr. Turner is a past member of the Canadian Wheat Board Advisory Committee (1969-1982) and was an Advisor to the Canadian Government during the Geneva United Nations Wheat Conference in 1971 and 1978.

He has visited China, India, Australia, and Europe, representing Canadian Agriculture on various missions and Conferences.

Presently, he is a member of the Conference Board of Canada, the International Trade Advisory Committee to the Canadian Government and chairman of the ITAC Task Force x "Agriculture."

He is Co-chairman of the College of Agriculture (University of Saskatchewan) Capital Campaign.
