Dave Christensen has spent most of his career in the Department of Animal and Poultry Science at the U of S, starting in 1965 as Assistant Professor and actively continuing today as Distinguished Professor Emeritus.

Dave's career has demonstrated excellence in teaching, research and administration and he is particularly known for his expertise in dairy nutrition. He has served on the Sask Milk Control Board and as technical advisor to Alberta Milk.

His research has included mineral, forage and other feed evaluation. This has been done in collaboration with 70 graduate students as well as other researchers. Dave has been recognized nationally and internationally for his work and has received numerous awards including being named a Member of the Order of Canada, induction into the SAHF (2011), and awarded the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Medal. But most importantly, Dave has been recognized and respected by the thousands of students that had passed through his classroom doors for 50 plus years.
