

Murray Edward Mooney was born in Saskatoon City Hospital on April 26, 1928 to Mabel and Albert Mooney of Leney, SK. He passed away on March 15, 2020 at Outlook Health Centre. Murray attended Sandy Plains, Granville and Perdue schools, also University of Saskatchewan where he obtained a Bachelor of Science degree in Agriculture. He married Elsa Jutta Horn RN on November 23, 1963. They farmed with his brother, Dick in Feudal area south of Perdue, SK, where they raised their children: Timothy, Sarah (Darrel) Weir and grandson Mark Weir, Christopher and grandson, Colton. They built a house in Perdue in 1975 following the winter of 1973-74, so the kids would have greater access to school activities.
