

**Campbell Garner Casswell Jan 15, 1925 – April 15, 2017**

The passing of Campbell Garner Casswell occurred at City Hospital on April 15, 2017 at the age of 92. Cam is survived by his children Barbara (John); Diane (Loyd); Chris (Mick); Janet (Mike); Gordon (Sherry), as well as grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Cam was predeceased by his wife of 66 years, Phyllis, his siblings and parents.

Campbell was born in Ituna, SK, the youngest of nine children. When he turned 18 he enlisted in the RCAF and was stationed at Gander, Nfld. A subsequent injury resulted in his discharge, and he returned to Saskatoon to continue his education. In 1947 he and Phyllis Thomas married while he continued his university studies to complete his BSA and a Masters in Science. His first job was as an Ag. Rep. in Melville, SK, and in 1975 he was appointed Regional Agriculture Coordinator in Kindersley, SK, until his retirement in 1984.

Prior to and during his retirement Dad's hobbies and interests included: gardening and horticulture, square dance calling, 4-H leadership, woodworking and furniture refinishing, and wine making. Dad always enjoyed meeting new people and sharing stories about life's experiences. In 2007 Mom and Dad moved to Saskatoon where they enjoyed the comforts of supported living. In 2015 Dad moved to Keedwell Assisted Living Inc., which he called home until his passing.
