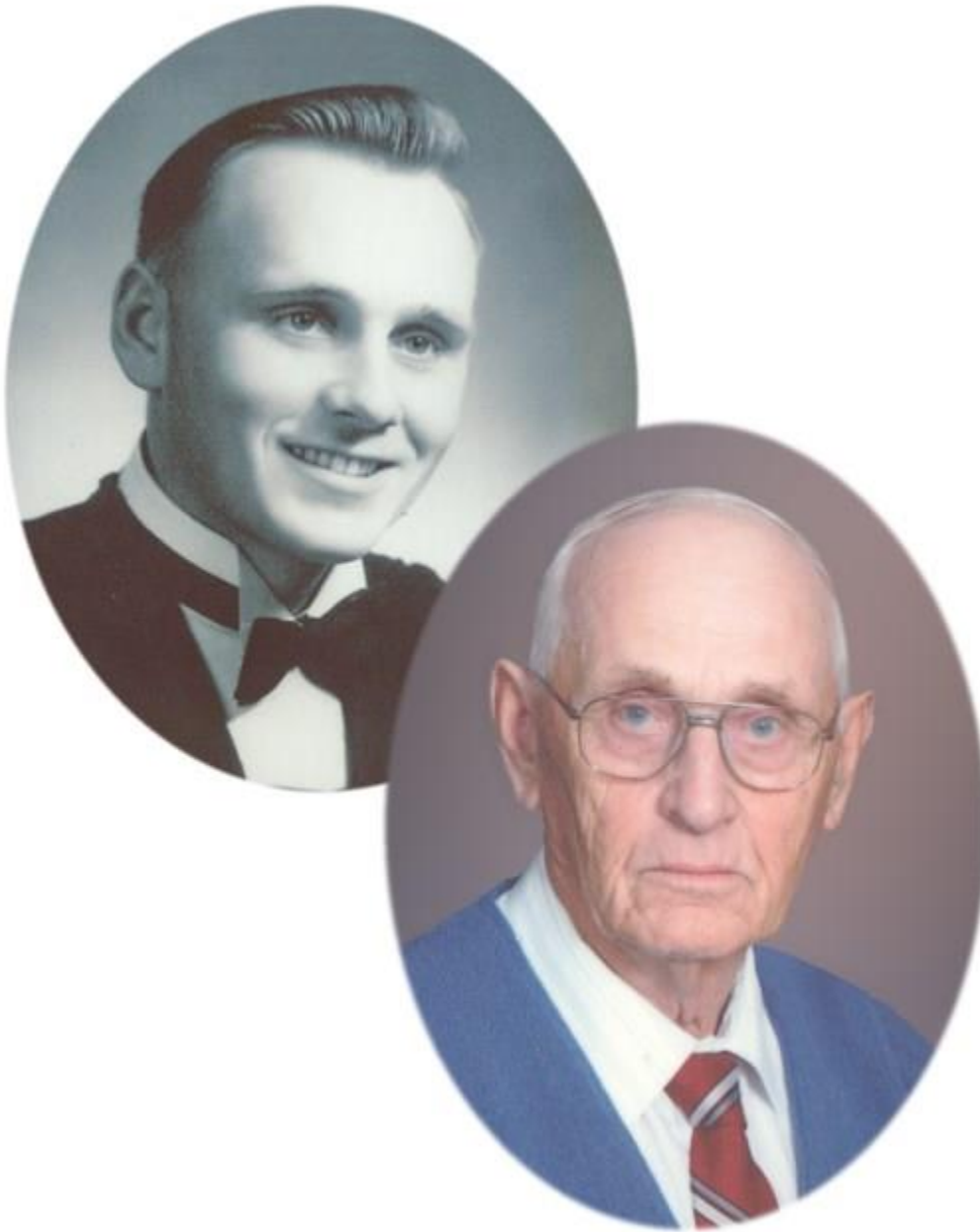


Stanley Robert Smith

Stanley Robert Smith, formerly of the rural Abernethy district and late of Balcarres passed away in the Balcarres Integrated Care Center on June 9, 2019.

Stan was born on July 24, 1932 in the Abernethy District, son of the late H.H. (Harry) and Charlotte (Emmerson) Smith. Stan was raised and received his public education in the rural district of Pheasant Plain/Blackwood and graduated from Indian Head High School. He attended

the University of Saskatchewan, received a Degree in Agriculture and for a number of years was a seasonal [Oct. – Apr] lecturer at the university while farming with his dad and brother Les. Stan married Audrey Hartall, November 6, 1971 and became a full time farmer. He retired from active farming in 1995, continuing to live on the farm for a number of years before moving to Balcarres.
