With broken hearts, the family of Richard Szwydky announces his sudden passing on Sunday, November 1, 2020 after a courageous three week battle with pancreatic cancer. Rich was born on July 26, 1970. He graduated from Blaine Lake School and attended the University of Saskatchewan where he received his Agriculture degree and diploma. He was well known in the Ag industry through his work at Ciba Geigy in Red Deer, Big Yield in Wilkie, Wendland Ag in Waldheim, Saskatchewan Soil Conservation Association and most recently Saskatoon Co-op Agro Centre. Rich married Corinne Tanchak on October 26, 1996 at the Ukrainian Catholic Cathedral of St. George. Records showed they were baptized together by the same priest on October 23, 1970. Their daughter Kirsten Ann was born in 2000. Together they built a beautiful life in Saskatoon and Borden, filled with simple joys, special times with family and friends, and memorable trips to Cuba, Disney World, Toronto and the US. Rich was the ultimate sports fan and a faithful follower of Kevin Cheveldayoff's teams. His true passion, however, was the family farm. He spent many years helping with seeding and harvest, eventually renting land and farming with his dad. Last year he fulfilled his lifelong dream of owning the "lake guarter" where he one day hoped to retire. Much like his parents, Rich always put the needs of others before his own. He was a kind, selfless man whose greatest challenge was time - he simply never had enough of it. Rich touched so many lives in his 50 years. God broke our hearts to prove he only takes the best.
