d) Banquet/Mixer - B. Larson C'77/E. Cuthbert C'11

- B. Larson met with David Keegan at TCU on Nov 14th, 2012.
- The present contract is for Salons A, B, C, E and the Blair Nelson Room. This area easily holds up to 500 people. The rental is at half, \$1300, if there are less than 350 attendees. If greater than 350, the rental is waived.
- If the banquet has between 250-300 persons, then only Salon A and B are needed. This area can accommodate up to 400 persons at a sit down function. No rental charge if 225 or more persons. If less than 225, then \$775 rent applies. The Blair Nelson room for the AGM has a rental fee of \$300. A new contract can be drawn up if the SAGA executive decides to make a change.
- The cost per person (meal, midnight buffet, coffee/tea, facility tech, GST, service charge, registration fee, room rent if applicable) range from:

200 people - \$68.41 (includes room rental)

224 people - \$65.36 (includes room rental)

225 people - \$61.01 (no room rent)

250 people - \$60.91 (no room rent)

300 people - \$59.08 (no room rent)
